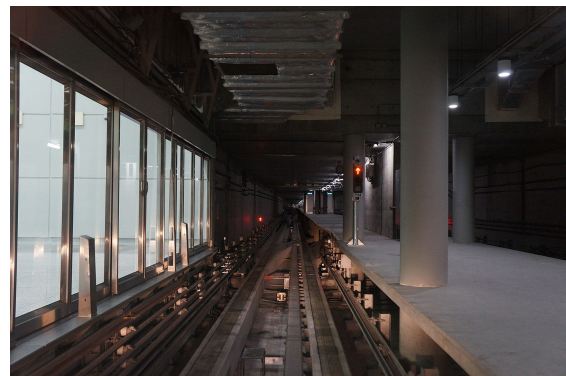

Technical Visit to Hong Kong International Airport (HKIA) Automated People Mover (APM) System

Abstract:

The Automated People Mover (APM) System in the Hong Kong International Airport transfers passengers between Terminal 1, Midfield Concourse and SkyPier, and Terminal 2 to Terminal 1. Travelling at approximately 60kph, this driverless electric train system carries about 7,200 passengers per hour and departs every few minutes. The APM system has recently undertaken a signalling upgrade to CBTC system. The visit will enrich participants with deeper understanding on the general organization and operations of the APM system.
