Abstract:

The century-old East Rail Line was originally served by a Signalling System which was due to be replaced and to allow its extension to Admiralty under the Shatin to Central Link (SCL) Project. The new Signalling System, including ATS, ATC, interlocking and data communication system was introduced and also enabled a new fleet of 9-car trains with better performance and more advanced technology to be introduced, allowing passengers to experience shorter waiting times and journey times.

Completely changing the Signalling System on an operating railway is like performing surgery on the brain and the entire nervous system while keeping the old organs functioning.

The presentation will cover the signalling system architecture, changeover methodology, challenges in T&C and system performance.
