## *Technical Visit to Shenzhen Metro Line 13*

### (深圳地鐵13號線)

**Date:** 26th July 2025 (Saturday)  
**Time:** 11:15 hrs. – 17:30 hrs.  
**Venue:** Shenzhen Metro Line 13 Depot and Houhai Station  
(including a lunch gathering at Shenzhen, China)

**Introduction:** The **Shenzhen Metro Line 13 (SZ Line 13)** is the second line operated by MTR Corporation (Shenzhen). The whole length of Shenzhen Metro Line 13 (SZ Line 13) is 45.75 Km with 30 stations. The Phase 1 South Section of SZ Line 13 was opened on 28 December 2024 with 7 stations and a length of 6.36 km. The line uses eight car type A trains for fully automatic driverless train operation with a maximum operating speed of 100 km/h.

**No. of Participants:** 25

**Admission Fees:** **Free-of-charge.**

- Every participant shall have to bear his/her own travelling expenses from Hong Kong to Shenzhen or vice versa.

The IRSE(HK) shall subscribe relevant group travel insurance to provide coverage of participants of the activity.
